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Change and Cancellation Policy

Cancellations

May 31, 2024: If for any reason a camper is unable to attend camp, a refund (minus the cancellation fees of 500,000 VND) will be issued.

June 1-14, 2024: We will issue you credit only** for all tuition fees paid for full or partial cancellations valid to December 2024. Your credit is transferable to any family member or friends and may be used for any Saigon Montessori programs.

After June 14, 2024: No refunds or credits will be given for any reason.

We are sorry, but there are no refunds or reductions in fees for days missed due to illness, absence, last-minute vacations/trips, change in family circumstances during camp sessions.

Camp Changes (by weekly)

If a camper is unable to attend camp, including but not limited to illness, injury, sickness, family emergency, and COVID, a refund/credit will not be issued. We will make every effort to reschedule the camper's camp week to a later week during the 2024 summer based on available space. The change fee applies

- Change 5 days before the camp start date. Change is subject to a 200,000 VND per change.
- Last-minute change (made on the start date) requires a 500,000 VND change fee.

WEEK 1: Jun 24 – Jun 28 / Tiny Seeds

These are just a handful of concepts kids can learn about seeds such as what foods come from seeds, what seeds look like and how they compare to others, seeds we eat and seeds we don't eat etc.

WEEK 2: July 1 – July 5 / World of Plants

We will learn all about what plants are, their relationship to the earth, their needs, their functions, the different parts of a plant and the names of plants that exist.

WEEK 3: July 8 – July 12 / Flower Power

Flowers are beautiful in sight and scent, but they are also so much more! We will learn about the types of flowers we grow, which ones are edible, which ones attract the bugs, and the many ways to create art from flowers. This week is sure to delight the senses, expect to eat some flowers, make delicious teas, and learn to make natural dyes!

WEEK 4: July 15 – July 19 / Creepy Crawlies

Jump, fly, and crawl into the world of fascinating bugs! Through crafts, activities, and games, kids will learn about all different kinds of bugs like beautiful butterflies, slimy slugs, and buzzing bumblebees.

WEEK 5: July 22 – July 26 / Feathered Friends

We will learn all about different kinds of birds, how their activity changes from season to season, where they sleep, what they eat, etc.

WEEK 6: July 29 – August 2 / Wonderful Weather

Children will have the opportunity to observe various weather patterns and their effects on garden plants. They will develop a better understanding of the changing seasons and how each one affects the garden.

WEEK 1: Jun 24 – Jun 28 / The Power Of Trees

What's it like to be a tree? Campers will spend the day exploring wildlife and plant ecology, adaptations, tracks and signs, and the complex system by which all things in an ecosystem are connected. Discover all the different types of trees and understand how they serve different purposes in our interconnected world. Learn how trees impact the animal world, and humans too!

WEEK 2: July 1 – July 5 / Bees & Pollinators

Nothing captures the attention of our campers more than finding a really cool bug or watching a beautiful butterfly at the park. Birds, bees and butterflies are flitting during the summer and we'd love to show them off by teaching youngsters the importance of these magnificent pollinators.

WEEK 3: July 8 – July 12 / Worms & Composting

What has no teeth in their mouth, but can eat almost one and a half times their own weight in one day? Learn about these tricky little slimy creatures, and how they can fool you! Campers will discover how nature made worms to be the perfect recyclers and underground farmers to help the green grass grow all around.

WEEK 4: July 15 – July 19 / Nature's Hide & Seek

Did you know that animals must hide and seek in order to survive? They have to hide from predators and seek out prey! Discover how animals use camouflage to both hide and seek during this week of camp. Campers will also explore the various adaptations of animals that enable them to survive in the wild.

WEEK 5: July 22 – July 26 / Whatever the Weather

Through exploration, experiments, and crafts, children will discover the many sides of weather; detecting in and making through it. Learn the importance of weather on all living things from plants to animals.

WEEK 6: July 29 – August 2 / Living Green

Find out how humans impact the environment, and understand the harmful effects of pollution. We explore the ins and outs of sustainable living such as organic gardening, composting, reducing your waste, green technology and more!
